37<sup>th</sup> Annual Sesser-Valier Holiday Tournament (December 26, 27, 28, & 29, 2017): In order for our tournament to continue having the success that it has had in the past, we need many volunteers. Some of you have volunteered during past tournaments, and we are deeply grateful for your help. We need your help again this year. Perhaps you have never assisted because you were not aware of the need. We need adults to volunteer in:

- 1. The kitchen to prepare food for the hospitality rooms,

## **Attending Evening Activities**

- During evening activities (such as basketball games, volleyball games, etc.), outside food and drinks should not be brought into the school building. Anyone bringing items into the building will be asked to dispose of them properly.
- When attending a game, individuals will not be allowed to walk under the bleachers to move from one side of the gym to the other. This is to ensure the safety of those attending the event.
- Fans are also asked to refrain from entering or exiting the gym while play is in progress. This will eliminate movement that could disrupt the basketball game while it is in progress. Fans are asked to only enter and exit the gym during a time out, during half time, and between quarters. This is for the safety of the fans and the players.
- The use of tobacco products is prohibited on school property. This includes the use of chewing tobacco in the building.

If you call the school (625-5105), after you hear the school's greeting, press "6" for updated information on school closings.

High School Academic Eligibility Requirements: A student participating in any team sport or extracurricular (non-graded) activity <u>must be passing all courses</u>. Grade checks will take place on Friday, every week. If a student is determined ineligible, he or she must remain ineligible for at least one week before grades are re-evaluated. Any work submitted to a teacher after 3:30 pm on Thursday prior to the grade check shall not be considered until the next eligibility check. For purposes of eligibility, an incomplete shall become a failing grade if not removed by the next grade check, unless there are extenuating circumstances as determined by the administration. In addition, a student must pass all courses at the end of each semester in order to be academically eligible for participation throughout the ensuing semester.

Junior High School Academic Eligibility Requirements: Students must satisfy all academic standards and comply with the activity's rules and the student conduct code. In order to participate in any extracurricular and/or co-curricular activity, students are required to receive passing grades in all classes each grading quarter. If a student receives a failing grade on his or her report card, then the student will be unable to participate in extracurricular and co-curricular activities during the next two grading periods. Once a student is participating in an extracurricular and/or co-curricular activity, he or she must continue to pass all courses that are used to determine a student's GPA. These eligibility checks will be performed each week of the season.
