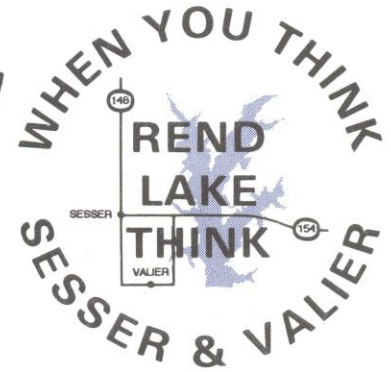

SESSER-VALIER HIGH SCHOOL SPORTSMANSHIP GUIDELINES

Effective 2023-2024 School Year

For the 2023-2024 school year and thereafter, fans, coaches, and/or players who have been removed and/or ejected from a Sesser-Valier High School event shall be subject to the following limitations:

For a first-removal and/or ejection of the school year:

- **Fans:** Not less than a 3-game suspension
- **Players:** Not less than a 2-game suspension (Not less than a 1-game suspension for high school football)
- **Coaches:** Not less than a 2-game suspension

For multiple removals/ejections in the same school year:

- **Fans:** Any fan who is removed and/or ejected twice (2 times) will result, at a minimum, in the fan not being allowed to attend any Sesser-Valier CUSD #196 event for the remainder of the school year. Fans who are barred from attendance at Sesser-Valier CUSD #196 events may, within ten (10) days after the 2nd removal and/or ejection, request a public hearing before the school board at which time the school board will review the incident(s) and consider the denial of future admission to school events or meetings.
- **Players:** Any player who is removed and/or ejected twice (2 times) will result, at a minimum, in a 4-game suspension. (Not less than a 2-game suspension for high school football)
- **Coaches:** Any coach who is removed and/or ejected twice (2 times) will result in a 4-game suspension.

For all fans, players, and coaches: More serious incidents may result in more restrictive consequences in addition to the guidelines listed above.

Any fan, player, or coach who has been ejected from a Sesser-Valier High School event must complete a District-approved sportsmanship course (e.g. NFHS website course) before being permitted to attend any Sesser-Valier CUSD #196 events. The course completion certificate or other District-approved proof must be submitted to Sesser-Valier CUSD #196 to complete the period and terms of the suspension.
