MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING BOARD OF EDUCATION SESSER-VALIER COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 196 APRIL 29, 2019 6:00 PM

CALL TO ORDER

A special meeting of the Board of Education of Sesser-Valier Community Unit School District No. 196 was held in the High School Library at 6:00 PM on Monday, April 29, 2019. The meeting was called to order by President Carroll Kelly.

PUBLIC COMMENT & CORRESPONDENCE

President Kelly asked for any visitor's comments. None were forthcoming.

Kevin Acosta asked to address the board regarding the side-letter agreement discussed last month; stating that he did not agree with the approval of the agreement.

SUPERINTENDENT: Mr. Henry, Superintendent, presented the following information to the board:

- 1. The consent agenda for this special meeting includes the following additional item(s):
 - Payment of bills;
 - Authorization of the 2018-2019 tentative amended district budget & scheduling a budget hearing on June 10, 2019, at 5:55 PM;
 - Approval of a maternity leave request.
- 2. The superintendent's employment contract includes a provision that requires Superintendent Henry to notify the board of any proposed use of vacation days that exceeds five consecutive business days. For Summer, 2019, he is planning to use vacation days for a family trip from

June 13, 2019, to June 20, 2019, and return to regular work days on June 21, 2019 (IASB New Board Member Training).

3. Superintendent Henry is anticipating a Summer (June), 2019, board discussion regarding school security measures (equipment & staffing), and asked board members to begin thinking about what direction the district should consider going in this regard. Over the 2018-2019 school year, the district has increased the day-to-day school work with the Sesser Police Department and have, with their cooperation, upgraded the two-way radio system to include police/Central Dispatch access & functionality. The district administrators are currently looking into a federal grant that may support some security equipment installations/upgrades, and Sheriff Bartoni has initiated a conversation among rural school districts about possibly sharing the cost of a school-assigned deputy (1 deputy sheriff assigned to help 5-6 schools).

Board agreed, by consensus, to approve Superintendent Henry vacation leave over five days.
